The Challenge!

- *How are we loving, and leading others to love, in “word and deed?”* Heb.10:24,25

- *Am I actively silencing accusations against God?* 1 Pet 2:12,15; Titus 2:7,8

- *Do we need to repent?*

- Prayer!
