3. Exercise own gifting in context of own group (1 Tim.4:13 – see also 2 Tim.1:6,7)

4. Shepherd your flock with both high support & high challenge

- **SUPPORT** (1 Thess. 2:7,8; 2 Tim. 1:2-5, 5:1,2 & 2Tim.4:2)
- **CHALLENGE** (1 Thess. 2:11,12; 1 Tim. 4:11; 5:7,20; 6:2; 2 Tim. 2:24-26; 4:2)

5. Stay focused on the mission & shun all sidetracks. (Col.1:28,29, 1 Tim. 1:3-6; 2 Tim. 2:14-18)
